

# The Edith Baker Art Scholarship

### Guidelines

#### **DESCRIPTION OF AWARD**

The Dallas Art Dealers Association presents The Edith Baker Art Scholarship to one senior visual arts student attending Booker T. Washington High School for the Performing and Visual Arts. The award will go toward covering the expenses of majoring in visual arts in college. The winner will have the opportunity to be mentored for a day and have a summer internship with DADA members of his/her choice at their businesses and to present the winning works as well as more recent works at a spring membership meeting of DADA members. All finalists also will have opportunity to exhibit and sell their submissions at the Norwood Flynn Gallery in April. Proceeds of the exhibition will benefit individual artists and future scholarships.

#### **RULES FOR ENTRY**

Applicants must:

Present ten (10) digital images of his/her works of art on a CD (JPEG file formats at 150ppi preferred) to BTWHSPA teacher Lollie Tompkins by February 1.

Complete a list of images (number the files on the CD to correspond to images on the list).

Provide resume, color jpeg headshot, and brief cover letter addressed to the DADA scholarship committee explaining plans for the future.

If chosen as finalist, a 10-minute jury presentation at Booker T. will be required featuring one new work and one from submission.

#### **MEDIA**

All visual art media will be accepted.

#### **NOTIFICATION**

The recipient(s) will be selected and notified in March and will be presented with a check at the scholarship awards event at BTWHSPVA.
